

Duluth-Superior RC Auction – 2026 Rules

- All buyers and sellers must register and receive a Bid Number.
 - Bid Number must be purchased before submitting an item for sale or bidding on an item.
 - Bid Numbers can be purchased on our website. A Bid Number and Item Tag form will be emailed.
 - The cost of a Bid Number is \$5.
- Auction Fee: 15% will be deducted from all items sold.
- All lots submitted for sale must be valued at a minimum of \$10.
 - Auction staff has the option to not accept a lot they value as not meeting this requirement.
- Submissions to be auctioned will be accepted between 6:30-8:45 am on Saturday, February 28.
 - Duluth-Superior RC Club is not responsible for items left or damaged.
 - All buyers and sellers are responsible for their items.
- Lot items should be ready to present including wings on planes. Better presentation means higher bids!
- **Sellers may NOT place a Reserve or Minimum Acceptable Bid on an item.**
 - Sellers may bid on their own item to increase bid to an acceptable level.
 - If Seller wins their own item, Seller will be charged either 15% of winning bid or \$15, whichever is less.
- It is the bidder's responsibility to assure the auctioneer recognizes your bid. Be vocal and visible!
- Item viewing is acceptable during the auction. Remain clear of active auction.
- **Auction to start promptly at 9:00 am.**
 - Bidding amount will start at Auctioneer's discretion but will not start below \$10.
 - Bid increments will be a minimum of \$5. No exceptions!
 - Auctioneer's ruling is **FINAL!**
- All items are sold "as is" with no guarantee, no exceptions. It is your responsibility for prior viewing.
- Accounts may be closed, and items received only during the following allotted times.
 - Lunch break and at the conclusion of the auction – **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
 - Buyers that close their account will not be able to bid on additional items.
 - Sellers can only close their account after all their submitted items are sold.
 - Items purchased must be checked by auction staff prior to exiting the building.
 - Please return auction paddles to Registration at account closing or prior to leaving.
- Bidders/Sellers must receive invoice from Registration and take to Finance to make or receive payment.
- Payments may be made via cash, check, PayPal, Venmo, Visa or Mastercard.
- All items left at the conclusion of auction will be recycled by the Duluth-Superior RC Club.
- The auction is not conducted by a professional auction house. Mistakes may occur. Please be courteous.
